This letter serves as the official notification, pursuant to New Hampshire Administrative Rule Ed. 511.01, that the New Hampshire Department of Education has formally opened an investigation into possible violations of the Code of Conduct for New Hampshire Educators.

Specifically, the Department of Education has become aware of actions, which, if substantiated, would be a violation of Ed. 510.02(b)(2)—Responsibility to Students—of the aforementioned Code of Conduct. Namely, the allegation is that you failed to properly supervise and abide by ethical standards regarding student boundary protocols with a student under your care [REDACTED] New Hampshire. These allegations fall both within the Code of Conduct and the [REDACTED] Policies. At the time of these incidents, you were employed as a [REDACTED]
